Our story came from an image I had of a prince receiving a kiss (like Sleeping Beauty) that brought him back to life. One afternoon, while Max and I were playing at the lake, the story about the sleeping prince grew.

The words kept flowing and, when I got stuck, Max would tell me what happened next. Max named all the characters, came up with the girl who could do karate and set the final scene.

The ending took an unexpected turn and both Max and I were amazed! I remember him looking at me and saying, "That was magic Auntie Tania!"

Since that day, a whole community of helpers, illustrators and editors has assisted in bringing our story to the page.
